A mural can make the setting part of the experience, giving guests a reason to look closer, take a photograph and start a conversation.



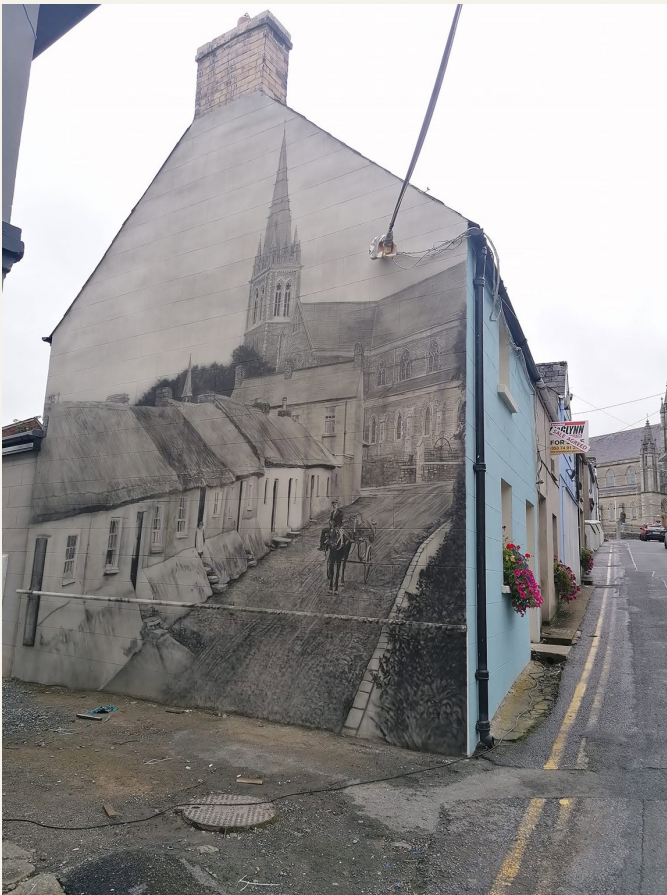
THE RUSTY MACKEREL

Art that invites the question: “What is the story behind that?”

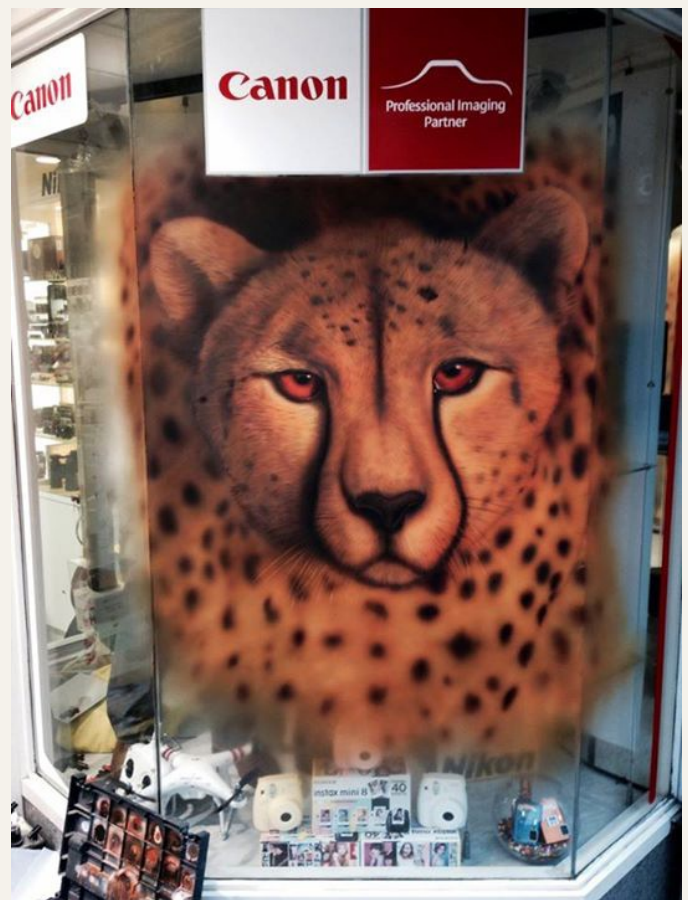
Turn a passing glance into a closer look.
